Dear Neighbor,

Pennsylvania is in a period of energy and momentum.

Last year, we won free breakfast for every school student to help keep kids nourished and allow them to focus on learning. We expanded

the Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program to ensure more Pennsylvanians can receive this crucial support. We passed the Dignity for Incarcerated Women Act to mandate trauma-informed care and practices in spaces notoriously cruel to women and their children. And the first round of Whole-Home Repairs Program dollars flowed into communities throughout the state, with work beginning on hundreds of homes to keep families warm, safe, and dry.

Our task now is to hold on to this momentum and to build on it. To do this, we need to acknowledge our current struggles and keep our focus on where we need to go. The workers we invest in today will become those who repair our homes and rebuild our infrastructure tomorrow. Allocating resources to fight the climate crisis right now will ensure Pennsylvania's people, lands, and economy remain resilient for years to come. Our support for safe, affordable housing, fully funded public schools, and higher wages will help strengthen families and bring safety, stability, and peace to whole communities.

VICTORY FOR SAFE STREETS Automated Speed Enforcement Passes!

The successful passage of **House Bill 1284** at the end of last year made automated speed enforcement on Roosevelt Boulevard permanent and expanded this lifesaving program to five additional roads and five school zones in Philadelphia. My office received messages from hundreds of constituents advocating for safer streets, and I was proud to support this bill and work for its passage in the Senate.

This victory is a direct result of the tireless work of advocates, organizers, and Philly neighbors who collected data on the urgent need, shared stories of the impact, and created a call so loud that Harrisburg could not ignore it.

All of us deserve to move safely through our streets. The passage of HB1284 is an important step toward this vision of safety and freedom of movement, and I'm committed to advancing legislation that keeps everyone safe on their journeys.
